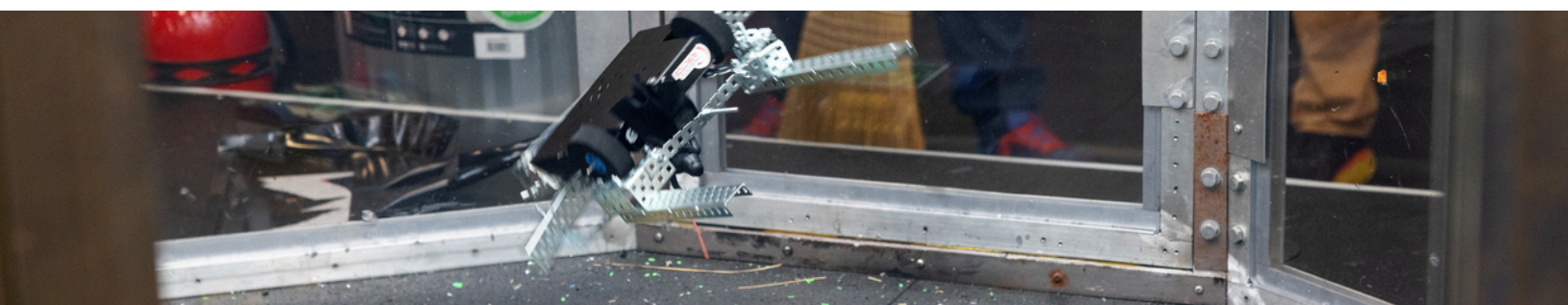
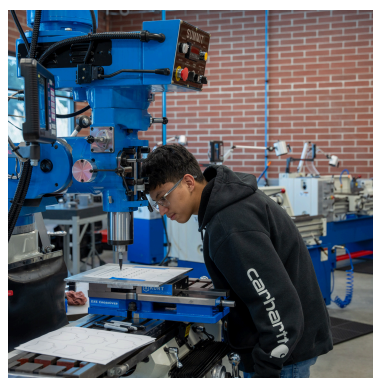
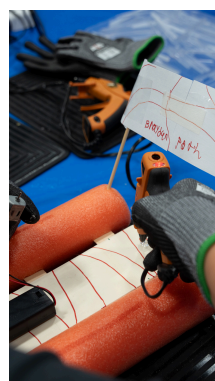

### STEAM-TO-CAREER COLLABORATIONS

#### *K-8 Teachers & Parents*

Students always ask, "Why am I learning this? When am I going to use this?" AWT STEAM-to-Career collaborations allow teachers to see and experience how the state educational standards connect directly to local industry. During our showcase, we teach a science, technology, engineering, art, or mathematics (STEAM) lesson, point out the STEAM connections during our tour of the manufacturing facility, and provide teachers with the supplies and curriculum to teach that lesson in their classroom.

## STEM-TO- CAREER CAMPS

### SUMMER MANUFACTURING INSTITUTE (SMI) CAMPS

#### *5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Students*

A STEM-to-career summer camp, where 5th and 6th graders will complete STEM projects, tour local manufacturing facilities, and learn workplace readiness. The goal of the camp is to expose 5th and 6th graders to STEM concepts and in-demand manufacturing careers.



### STEM DAY CAMPS

#### *Elementary & Middle School Students*

AWT STEM Days are day camps that connect Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) concepts to local careers throughout Lake County. Campers will complete hands-on STEM projects to engage creativity and problem-solving.

### AWT WORKADVANCE

The AWT WorkAdvance program aims to introduce job seekers to entry-level positions in manufacturing through a short training program at our facility. Each day, a new topic relating to the manufacturing sector is covered. The program includes days focused on blueprint reading, inspection and measurement, shop math, and intro to manual and CNC machines. We cover resume and interview prep, financial literacy, and workplace etiquette. At the conclusion of the program, participants are matched with manufacturers for interviews.

### JUNIORBOTS

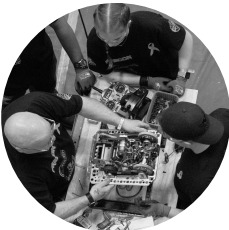
*Middle School Students*
